TEMPORARY DISABILITY INSURANCE OVERVIEW

Temporary Disability Insurance ("TDI")

- 1. TDI is required by law.
- 2. TDI is a "wage replacement" benefit for non-work-related injury or sickness, including a disability caused by pregnancy or termination of a pregnancy.

TDI Benefits

- 1. 58% of average weekly wages rounded up to the next higher dollar.
- 2. Maximum of \$765.00 per week (2023).
- 3. There is a 7-day elimination period therefore benefits are payable from the 8th day of disability.
- 4. Maximum of 26 weeks of benefits paid during a benefit year. A "benefit year" is twelve (12) months from the date of disability.

Maximum Taxable Payroll for 2023

Eligibility

- 1. The injury or illness is not work-related.
- 2. The disability is certified by a licensed physician.
- 3. The claimant was employed immediately before the date of disability. (For unemployed claimants, the disability occurred within 2 weeks of his/her job separation date.)
- 4. The claimant must have been employed for at least 14 weeks during each of which he/she was paid 20 hours or more and earned wages of at least \$400 during the fifty-two (52) weeks immediately preceding the first day of disability.
